Motorbike for Hampshire Fire and Rescue

A new fire bike is set to hit the streets of Hampshire.

The silver Triumph Sprint GT is part of a new road safety initiative to reduce the number of motorcyclists killed or seriously hurt across the county every year.

Being launched today the RideSMART scheme will see the new vehicle, badged by Hampshire Fire and Rescue, used in schools and demonstrations as the service promotes protective clothing and aims to increase the skill levels of riders.

RideSMART aims to raise awareness of motorcycle safety to motorcyclists of all ages and ranges of skills within Hampshire, at places across the county such as schools, colleges, public events and popular motor biking haunts. To promote safety to younger riders, we have introduced RideSMALL

RideSMART promotes the key messages of;

- [Motorcycle skills](#) - have the right skills for your bike
- [Motorcycle maintenance](#) - keeping your bike maintained
- [Motorcycle hazards and risks](#) - be aware of the hazards and risks

- [Motorcycling and other road users](#) - respect other road users
- [Motorcycle clothing](#) - tailor your clothing to suit
- [Scooter and moped safety tips](#) - RideSMALL

The RideSMART bike is very distinctive being in the RideSMART colours (red and silver) and logo as a way of attracting the attention of motorbike enthusiasts. When you see the RideSMART bike at events, please stop by and have a talk with us and we will be delighted to offer advice and guidance on safety and related issues.

Our firefighters are highly trained people who approach their duties professionally and with appropriate personal protective equipment. They would never be able to do their job without proper training, protective equipment or full risk awareness. RideSMART follows the same approach. It should be the same for you as a motorcycle rider, to be well trained and prepared for what may lay ahead.

The RideSMART bike is a Triumph Sprint GT sponsored by Triumph UK through local dealership Destination Triumph, we will engage positively with motorcyclists on a range of safety and related issues. Helping us to promote safer riding and reduce the number of motorcycling casualties in Hampshire.
